RACE OFFICIALS

Race Organizer: innsbruck-tirol sports GmbH
Race Director: Sabine Oswald (Mountain Bike Movement)
Track Manager: to be confirmed
UCI functionaries: to be confirmed

RACE PLATES

Only riders with race plates will be permitted on course during official training. Altering, cutting or placing of unauthorized sponsors' logos on race plate will result in a fine and/or disqualification. This includes writing on the race plate with a marker. Riders must display their handlebar number while training as well as their back number during the final.

TRAINING RUNS

It is mandatory for all racers to complete 2 training runs prior to starting their race run. Riders must start all training runs at the official start gate.

SEEDING RUNS

Crankworx Downhill races will use a Finals only format – no seeding runs. Riders will be seeded for the Finals based on their UCI rank and past Crankworx Downhill Race results.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

A rider must act in a sporting manner at all times and must permit any faster rider to overtake without obstructing.

RE-ENTERING COURSE

If a rider exits the course for any reason, he/she must return to the course at the same point from which he/she exited.

RE-RUNS

Re-runs, when a rider is permitted to do an additional timed run, will only be granted for those riders who are already on course when a medical or other course hold occurs. These riders must report to the official at the finish line to request the re-run. Re-runs will not be granted to faster riders blocked by slower riders. Slower riders are expected to yield to faster riders.

MISSED OR LATE STARTS

Racers arriving late for their scheduled start should report to the Start Referee who will determine if the racer will be permitted to start at a later time. The top 6 Elite women and 25 Elite men will have fixed start times. For DH races which are webcasted live - no late racer will be inserted into the start order once this group has started.

TIMING PROTESTS

Protests concerning the result or conduct of an event must be made within 15 minutes of the unofficial announcement of the result of the event (or category). If no protest is made, the results become official.

CAMERAS

According to the UCI rules, cameras are not permitted during qualifying rounds and finals. The riders are responsible for securing the fixation of the cameras in order to avoid any danger. The UCI can decide to allow a camera during finals but only for the usage of the TV production company.

RIDER PROTECTION

It is MANDATORY for riders to wear:

- a fullface helmet
- knee, elbow and back protection
- gloves with full hand protection
- shirt with at least short sleeves

A neck brace and shoulder pads are highly recommended.

Helmets must be full face and of a one-piece design. Slimmed down 'Enduro' full face helmets are not advised. Helmet straps must be closed on course.

The local organizer is responsible for enforcing compliance with gear regulations. Failure to comply with gear regulations will result in disqualification.

EMERGENCY SERVICES / FIRST AID MANAGEMENT

Race medical services are provided on site during training sessions and competition. There are several hospitals, doctors and physiotherapists close to the location. Please ask at the info service on-site for further details.

The participant explicitly confirms the correctness of all data of the registration.

WITHDRAWAL

The racing officials hold the right to withdraw starters if they feel there is a danger for the starter or any other person. The racing doctor can advise the race organisers that due to medical reasons a rider should be withdrawn from the event. If the race organiser follow the recommendation, the rider will have their number board removed and will be withdrawn from the event. The withdrawn rider will not be eligible for a refund or a transfer. If the race organisers believe a rider is not capable to tackle the race course they reserve the right to withdraw the rider from the event on grounds of their safety and that of the other riders and spectators. The withdrawn rider will not be eligible for a refund or a transfer.
