

KING and QUEEN

The race to be named King or Queen of the Crankworx World Tour is the most difficult competition in mountain biking. This season-long, multidisciplinary challenge tabulates results from multiple event disciplines in a four-stop, epic test of a rider's skill and will. Racing from the Southern Hemisphere to the Alps, athletes aim to collect as many points as possible for a shot at winning the \$20,000 prize. The most points wins.

TITLES / PRIZE MONEY

The top ranked athletes competing at the Crankworx World Tour are recognized through the following title and awards.

King and Queen: the two top ranked riders (male and female) will each receive \$20,000 CAD

The **second** place overall rider (male and female) will each receive \$10,000 CAD

The third place overall rider (male and female) will each receive \$5,000 CAD

Titles/Awards will be presented on August 19 at Crankworx Whistler.

ELIGIBILITY

A rider must compete and collect points in at least 2 disciplines in order to be eligible to win a title/award. Only riders competing in the Pro Men or Pro Women categories will be eligible.

POINTS

DOWNHILL

Points: 1st 150 | 2nd 100 | 3rd 75 | 4th 50 | 5th 40 | 6th 30 | 7th 25 | 8th 20 | 9th 15 | 10th 10 *Only top 10 in a category will receive points. (only top 5 if a category has 20 or less competitors).*

ENDURO

Points: 1st 225 | 2nd 150 | 3rd 115 | 4th 75 | 5th 60 | 6th 45 | 7th 35 | 8th 30 | 9th 25 | 10th 15 Only top 10 in a category will receive points. (only top 5 if a category has 20 or less competitors).

DUAL SPEED AND STYLE, DUAL SLALOM, AND PUMPTRACK

Points: 1st 150 | 2nd 100 | 3rd 75 | 4th 50 | 5th 40 | 6th 30 | 7th 25 | 8th 20

For events with a head to head elimination format (Dual Speed and Style, Dual Slalom, and Pumptrack), points will be awarded to top 8 for Finals with 16 or more riders. Points will be awarded to top 4 for Finals with 15 or less riders. For Speed&Style, the Qualifier time will be used to determine places 5-8 (when applicable). For Pumptrack and Dual Slalom, seeding rank will be used to determine places 5-8 (when applicable). No points for riders finishing 9-10th.

SLOPESTYLE

Points: 1st 150 | 2nd 100 | 3rd 75 | 4th 50 | 5th 40 | 6th 30 | 7th 25 | 8th 20 | 9th 15 | 10th 10

WHIP OFF

Points: 1st 100 | 2nd 75 | 3rd 50

TIE BREAK

In the event of a tie on total points at the end of the World Tour series, the following rules will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- (a) The most first place finishes, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most 3rd place finishes, or if still tied,
- (b) Head-to-Head results in all common races/competitions if applicable.
- (c) In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided.
