

# CRANKWORX WORLD TOUR

The Crankworx Summer Series Canada (CSSC) will tabulate results from multiple competition disciplines, in a three-stop, epic test of a rider's skill and will. Racing from British Columbia to Quebec, athletes can aim to collect as many points as possible for a shot at winning a piece of the \$7500 CAD series overall prize purse.

## **PRIZE MONEY & ELIGIBILITY**

Riders competing in at least one of the competitions listed below will receive points and appear on the CSSC rankings.

The categories of Open Men and Open Women will be vying for an overall series prize purse of \$7500, allocated as follows:

- Men's / Women's 1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$2000
- Men's / Women's 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$1000
- Men's / Women's 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: \$750

Crankworx will be tracking these rankings across all categories. However, the prize purse will only be awarded to the Men's and Women's Open categories.

Awards will be presented to the Open Men and Open Women champions at the final event of the CSSC at Empire 47 in Quebec.

## **TIE BREAK**

In the event of a tie for total points at the end of all relevant Crankworx World Tour competitions, the following rules will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- (a) The most first place finishes, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most 3rd place finishes, or if still tied,
- (b) Head-to-Head results in all common races/competitions if applicable.
- (c) In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided.
